Pastor and Co-Pastor Welcomes You All To Our Corporate Consecration And Fast, Entitled... **“ INDOMITABLE... THERE IS GLORY AHEAD!”**

Definition: “Not easily discouraged, defeated or subdued; unyielding; unconquerable.”

When God speaks, it is done. When He says “Glory Ahead,” it is settled. That is, glory around the corner for you. Congratulations! It is with great joy that I welcome you to this year’s Corporate Consecration and Fast.

I assure you, in the name of the One who is called, “The King of Glory” and the Source of all that is truly glorious, that; your life will never be the same after this season of Consecration. When God showed a little of His glory to Moses, his face shone so much that the people were afraid to come near him. He had to wear a veil to cover his face (Exodus 34:29-35). You are here for a special encounter with the Almighty God. Do not allow anyone or anything to distract you. Hook unto the King of Glory – He is the reason why you are here.

Once again, welcome to the Presence of the Almighty God, for a very special encounter over the next 11 days.

This is your personal invitation to become *indomitable*. Why? Because “**THERE IS GLORY AHEAD!**”

“2019: “INDOMITABLE... THERE IS GLORY AHEAD!”

(Daniel 1:11-20)

(Please read prior to fasting)

The fast will begin on **Wednesday January 2nd (Midnight)** through **Sunday January 13th (Midnight)**. The fast will consist of the following:

- Water
- Salads
- Vegetables (fresh or canned)

NOTE:

You CAN use condiments in moderation such as:

- Salad Dressing
- Butter
- Salt/Pepper
- Etc.

PLEASE BE REMINDED THAT—SALADS should NOT include ANY meat and/or PASTA PRODUCTS!

THERE SHOULD BE NO:

Snacks of any kind (“junk food”), including *candies, mints, gum*, etc.

Breads

Meats/dairy products/pastas/cheeses

Sodas, coffee, tea, energy drinks, etc.

Newspapers/ secular reading material

TV/secular movies and/or music

No Fried Foods

Abstain from *all* sexual activities

Avoid sensuous phone calls/conversations/internet searches/reading material, etc.

Discontinue addictive attitudes, habits, etc.

A very strong caution is issued to those who excessively use Facebook, Instagram and all other social media venues.

NOTE: Those who are under doctor’s care or have health problems, please consult your physician prior to participating in the fast.

NOTE: Parents may modify the fast for all children who wish to share.

NOTE: If you are already a practicing vegetarian, discontinue those things that you are aware of that keep the Holy Spirit from having free reign in your life.

* Each member is asked to set aside a **minimum** of \$20.00 per day of the fast; to be given January 13th during a “special prayer/communion and anointing session”. (A minimum seed of \$220.00 should be prepared for sowing at the conclusion of the fast.)

**Children under 18(or those on a fixed income), set aside \$10.00 per day (\$110 total)*

**Children under 12(modified FAST w/ Parental assistance) set aside \$3.00/day (\$33.000 total)*

SELECT A CONVENIENT TIME FOR YOU EACH DAY TO:

Resubmit yourself to the *Lordship* of Christ, to avoid repeating “old” habits. (Luke 6:46)

Commit yourself to being an on-time, active member in the ministry. (Hebrews 10:25)

Pray for the leadership and vision of Faith United Ministries (Hebrews 13:17)

Purpose to become a “soul winner” for the advancement of the Kingdom (Proverbs 11:30)

*(1 soul per month)

Determine to be a faithful tither and seed sower in the ministry. (Proverbs 3:9)

Commit yourself to being a "good steward" over the finances that God allows to come your way. (Matthew 18:23-35)

Day 1:

"PURPOSE!"

THOUGHT:

"The frustration for many is that, they are not experiencing the success (fulfillment) that they desire. Success is not found in the *busy-ness* of activity, but in the *doing* of one's purpose"

SCRIPTURE READING:

Romans 8:26-30

MEMORY VERSE:

(PLEASE MEMORIZE) Romans 8:28

PRAYER FOR THE DAY:

"Father, Let Your purpose for my life, become the priority of my life, today..." IJMN. Amen!

Day 2:

"IT'S IN ME!"

THOUGHT:

"True greatness is not always recognized. However, in the process of time, as one sheds layers of mediocrity through effort, what one *truly* is, comes to the surface."

SCRIPTURE READING:

Isaiah 60:1-7

MEMORY VERSE:

(PLEASE MEMORIZE) Romans 8:18

PRAYER FOR THE DAY:

“Father, whatever has hindered me from being the best representative of You, today I release it... take it away from me,” IJMN. Amen!

Day 3:

“KNOWING MY PLACE”

THOUGHT:

“LISTEN! You cannot properly *operate in* what you lack the *knowledge of*. The difference between what one can access and another can’t, is what he knows.”

SCRIPTURE READING:

Matthew 6:25-34

MEMORY VERSE:

(PLEASE MEMORIZE) Matthew 6:9-13

PRAYER FOR THE DAY:

“Father, As I am *exposed* to truth, give me the grace to *walk* in the truth that I learn,” IJMN. Amen!

Day 4:

“REIGNING”

THOUGHT:

“The struggle in the life of many Christians is that, they have accepted a *teaching* (relationship) of *liberation*, but still have the *mentality* of one in *bondage* (slavery)!”

SCRIPTURE READING:

I Corinthians 15:12-28

MEMORY VERSE:

(PLEASE MEMORIZE) Romans 12: 1, 2

PRAYER FOR THE DAY:

“Father, Grant me the grace to live as delivered *mentally* as you have set me free *spiritually*.” IJMN. Amen!

Day 5:

“THE EXAMPLE”

THOUGHT:

“Rather than to follow the established pattern for a successful life, many, mistakenly, seek to establish their own. This leads to continuous failure, frustration and futility.”

SCRIPTURE READING:

II Timothy 3:1-9

MEMORY VERSE:

(PLEASE MEMORIZE) John 8:32

PRAYER FOR THE DAY:

“Father, My mind is cluttered. During this consecration, please give me a *mental enema*, so that I can receive your truth,” IJMN. Amen!

Day 6:

“HANDLING WEALTH!”

THOUGHT:

“Failure to know how to properly handle and utilize resources, causes heaven to withhold what should have been released.”

SCRIPTURE READING:

Proverbs 22 (Entirety)

MEMORY VERSE:

(PLEASE MEMORIZE) Proverbs 13:22

PRAYER FOR THE DAY:

“Father, above all else, give me a passion for the Kingdom, and the grace to trust you for the rest,” IJMN. Amen!

Day 7:

“OPENING THE LOCKS”

THOUGHT:

“A *door*, A *combination* or an *account* is only closed to the one who does not know the code, have the key or have the password. *ACCESS IS AVAILABLE!*”

SCRIPTURE READING:

Revelation 3:7-13

MEMORY VERSE:

(PLEASE MEMORIZE) Revelation 3:20

PRAYER FOR THE DAY:

“Father, From today onward, give me the grace to walk into every door that you have placed before me,” IJMN. Amen!

Day 8:

“THE KEY!”

THOUGHT:

“It is the knowledge that one *has of*, and the relationship that one *has with*, the owner of the house; that determines how much they have *access to* the things of the house.

SCRIPTURE READING:

Matthew 16:1-20

MEMORY VERSE:

(PLEASE MEMORIZE) Luke 12:32

PRAYER FOR THE DAY:

“Father, As I empty myself, give me a hunger for more of You,” IJMN. Amen!

Day 9:

“COMMITMENT TO DESTINY”

THOUGHT:

“LISTEN... it is not that we don’t have lofty goals, noble desires and good dreams. We simply lack the discipline to *follow through* on our *startups!*”

SCRIPTURE READING:

Habakkuk 2:1-14

MEMORY VERSE:

(PLEASE MEMORIZE) Proverbs 29:18

PRAYER FOR THE DAY:

“Father, Grant me the grace and the determination to live a life of discipline.” IJMN. Amen!

Day 10:

“GLORY AHEAD”

THOUGHT:

“Because the Almighty God *finishes a project* when He starts it, the best, that He has promised, *is already ours*. We simply have to go through the process to prepare *us for it.*”

SCRIPTURE READING:

Isaiah 46:8-13

MEMORY VERSE:

(PLEASE MEMORIZE) Proverbs 3:35

PRAYER FOR THE DAY:

“Father! Remove far from me, any anxiety over the future. Help me to rest in You.” IJMN. Amen!

Day 11:

“OIL FOR MY FUTURE”

THOUGHT:

“Just as the engine of a vehicle must go in on a *consistent basis* for an oil change, so the Believer needs a fresh touch periodically, to keep from experiencing *knocks* in the spirit!”

SCRIPTURE READING:

Psalm 133 (ENTIRETY)

MEMORY VERSE:

(PLEASE MEMORIZE) Psalm 92:10

PRAYER FOR THE DAY:

“Father! The anointing that I receive tonight, let it bring an end to all distress, debt, disease, doubt and

despair in my life, as well as the life of my family!"
